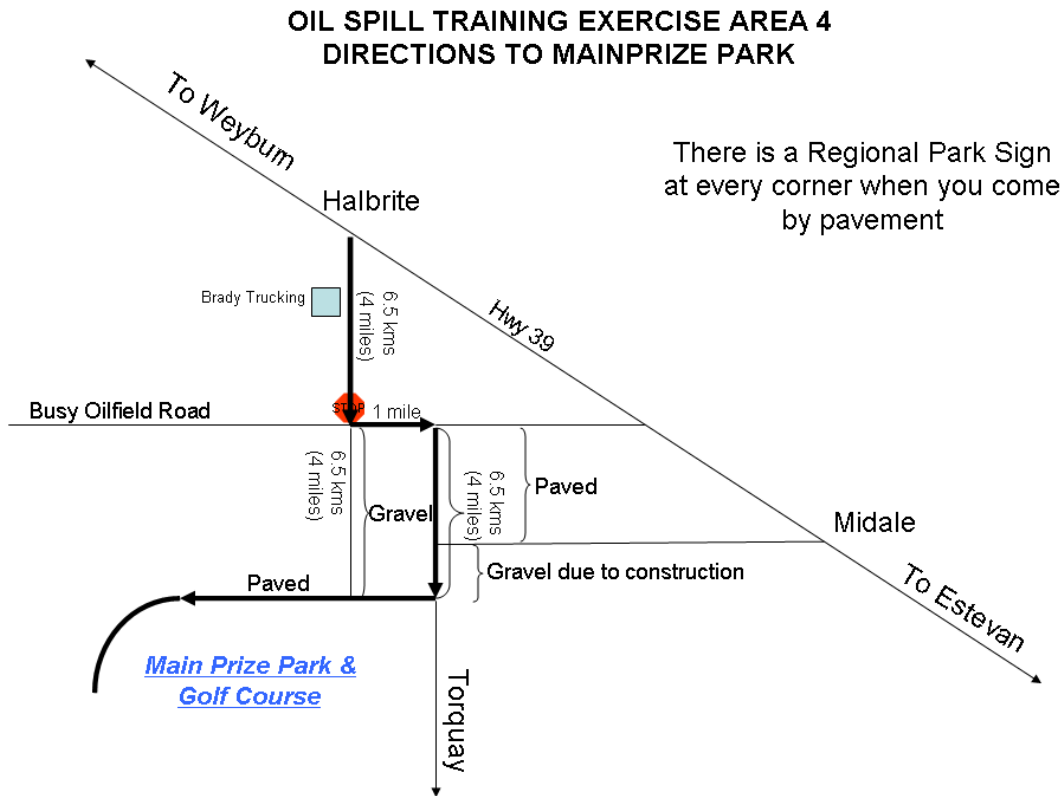

LOCATION

Moose Creek Regional Park is situated approximately 3 km North of the Alameda Dam on the eastern shore of the Reservoir. The Dam is located approximately 3 km east of Alameda or **6 km north of Oxbow**. Access is gained from either highway No. 9 or 18.

From Estevan to Moose Creek Regional Park via SK-18 E.

49 min (70 km)

49 min in current traffic

1. Head north on SK-18 E/SK-47 N toward SK-39A
2. Turn right onto SK-18 E/SK-39A (signs for SK-39)
3. Turn left to stay on SK-18 E
4. Turn left onto Marconi Rd
5. Turn left
6. Turn right
7. Arrive at location: Moose Creek Regional Park
